

Term 1 2012 ASP Clubs & Activities

Kiwiana Ceramics-Art Studio

Students will study the various objects associated with our own Kiwiana Culture and use this as inspiration for their clay creations, from Jandals to Kiwifruit, Gumboots to Buzzy Bees. While doing this they will learn hand building techniques and how to throw a pot on the wheel for their favourite Kiwi Kids breakfast cereal Weetbix.

Please note there is an activity and materials charge of \$124 per child per term for this club

Culture Club –Art Studio

Each week children will study a different culture and make a piece of art that responds to the music and craft from that part of the world.

3d Objects in Space-Art Studio

a chance to experiment with sculpture and 3D. Students will use a variety of exciting art mediums to inspire their suspended creations.

Open Studio –Art Studio

A chance for the students to make their own choices. There will be lots of drawing, painting, collage and adventure.

IT Club

Children explore IT and learn to use it confidently and with purpose to achieve specific outcomes. Children will have a focus on numeracy and literacy. They will become familiar with hardware and software which will enable them to develop their ideas and record their work.

Dance Club

Join our very own choreographer and dancer Salina in the dance studio each week to learn new moves, routines and steps. This term Salina will be focusing on fluid dance moves and styles to fit with the term theme of 'Kiwiana'. Participants will have the opportunity to show everyone their new moves at the end of term performance- Parents/Caregivers are welcome to attend.

Kiwiana Club

Members will be immersed in all things 'Kiwiana', they will have the opportunity to create their own designer Jandals, make Poi and play traditional Maori Stick Games, there is a Weetbix eating competition as well as quizzes, a movie day and scavenger hunt.

Science Experiments

Each week we will do a different science experiment. We will be learning about all sorts of experiments you can do at home using magnets & electricity, the human body and regular items you have around your house.

Park n Skate

Get outdoors and enjoy the summer weather at the local park. Keen skaters can have the opportunity to join in group games as well as enjoying the skate park. Youthtown has limited equipment for children to use and are welcome to bring their own skate boards and scooters from home.

Helmets are compulsory and participants must have shoes, sunhat and sunscreen as well as a signed permission slip to participate in this club outside the Youthtown facility.

Turbo Touch

Turbo Touch™ combines elements of Touch, Netball, Basketball and Ultimate Frisbee into a fast-paced game like no other – it's jam-packed with action and perfect for all fitness levels and abilities. Unlike traditional Touch, the

ball can be passed forwards (and backwards, sideways, any way you like!) with teams only having two possessions to create a Touchdown; this creates an expressive style of play that people can't seem to get enough of.

Cooking

Cooking around the theme of 'Kiwiana' members will be able to create delicious treats from recipes from start to finish. Children will be provided with recipes to take home at the end of the term.

Open Cooking

Now on **Fridays** and is available for those children who are not registered with in regular cooking club.

Book Club

The book club is about quiet reading together followed by group discussion around the topic and points of interest from the story. Children will be provided with a choice of picture books and chapter books which they will read and complete book reviews. This gives the children an opportunity to recommend books to other children from our extensive library.

Accessorize Club

Each week participants will look at different craft/jewellery techniques and create a range of cool cell phone charms, friendship bracelets, Bookmarks, necklaces and badges.

Rotten Mondays

Are you interested in the past? Do you like to solve mysteries and answer age old questions? Become a Junior Archaeologist at Auckland Museum. Part Scientists, part detectives you will join the Museum's team of Archaeological specialists to learn about artefacts of the past. Children will depart Youthtown at 3.45pm and return between 5.15 and 5.30pm depending on traffic.

There is an extra charge of \$40.00 per term for this club to cover activity costs and additional transportation.

Outdoor Sports

Participate in games, learn some new sports skills and join in with fun activities with your friends and supervisors in the summer sun at Victoria Park.

All participants must have shoes, sunhat and sunscreen as well as a signed permission slip to participate in this club outside the Youthtown facility.

Craft Club

'Kiwiana' themed craft items for our Discovery Centre display which participants will be able to take home at the end of the term. Each week there will be a different craft activity using a different technique or using medium to work with.

Electronics Club

Following on from the popular Model Clubs of Terms 3 and 4 in 2011 we will now offer an 'Electronics Club. Participants will learn about simple circuits and electricity as well as creating their own mouse or radio.

Students will form a working party of 8. We will visit graffiti sites near Youthtown, and discuss the artistic merits of the work we find. We will check out public art work from our local area and use the internet to investigate similar trends in other parts of New Zealand and overseas. We will visit an art studio in the inner city during the term and then work towards producing a collaborative piece or urban-inspired artwork to be installed at Youthtown Central using graffiti art and stenciling techniques.

There is an extra charge of \$124.00 per term per child for this club.

Camouflage

Our new exciting art offering is to introduce you to the wonderful world of Trash to Fashion and Wearable Art. We will search and sort through a collection of amazing old fabrics, jewelry and junk. We will select, cut, paint, print, pleat, stitch, bead and emboss our selected pieces with a view to use them to create a masterpiece for you to wear on your head, arms, hands, feet or body. Our inspiration for design will come from a visit to the Auckland Zoo where we will draw and photograph exotic and native birds and animals, incorporating some of these fantastic patterns into our work.
